Annotation: Argues that although post-European settlement has led to decline, or loss, of traditional land management regimes much knowledge remains; experience in Cape York Peninsula is that senior traditional owners maintain connectivity with country and knowledge related to land management; changes in Indigenous policy to meet changing needs but argues traditional knowledge remains; need to empower people with traditional knowledge; need to have stakeholders on Cape York working together for co-ordinated fire regimes, rather than each with their own; Balkanu has projects to document traditional land (including fire) management but with understanding that knowledge has to be passed on to suitable people only and that this is in the hands of the traditional owners; Balkanu facilitates traditional management of country, including opportunities for knowledge transfer to young people
